Important Information-Please Read!

ArtCamp Entrance Location: Please enter through doors located in the center of the building. Look for the signs marked **ArtCamp**.

Comings and Goings: Please plan to arrive a few minutes early on Monday and accompany your child to the check-in table. Arrangements should be made to drop off and pick up your child at the beginning and ending times for the program each day. Please sign your child in and out on the daily sheet to allow staff to account for every child.

Program Drop Off: 8:50 am – 9:00 am

Program Pick Up: 2:55 pm – 3:05 pm

Alternate Transportation Form:

If your child will be going home with anyone other than his or her parent, please fill out the Alternate Transportation Arrangements Form provided below. Should a last minute change occur with picking up your child, please call the camp and let us know. No exceptions will be made for your child’s safety.

Cell Phone Policy: Cell phone use (including photo taking) is prohibited during camp hours and should not be used in classrooms. Campers may keep cell phones with their lunch boxes. The ArtCamp staff and First Presbyterian Church are not responsible for lost or stolen cell phones.
